



Uniform and Equipment Policy

1. General:

- 1.1. All players are required to provide their own soccer cleats and shin guards, which should be worn at all games and practices.
- 1.2. It is the Policy of the Club that all Club coaches, team officials, assistant coaches and players representing the Club at an official Club activity must wear a Club approved uniform, track suit or other warm up gear.
- 1.3. Members/Teams are not allowed to modify or alter Club approved uniforms or other gear in any way.
- 1.4. Members/Teams are not allowed to use the Club crest or other Club letterhead or logos without written approval by the Board of Directors.

2. Development Programs

- 2.1. The Club will provide Program specific gear for each of its programs. The cost of which is included in the player registration fee.

3. Recreational Uniform

- 3.1. The Club will provide all recreational teams with a uniform (socks, shorts and jersey) which becomes the property of the player. The cost of which is included in the player registration fee.

4. Competitive Team Uniform

- 4.1. Official Club uniforms for competitive players are selected by the Club and must be purchased from the Club or from the Club's approved supplier.
- 4.2. Uniforms are paid for by the player and become the property of the player.
- 4.3. No other uniforms may be purchased or worn by competitive teams.
