<b>LENGTH</b>	March try-outs and evaluation April to September	September/October try-outs & evaluation November to February
<b>COMPETITIVE ACTIVITIES</b>	OYSL ERSL - Regional Ontario Cup ERSL Shield & ERSL Cup Tournaments	Coliseum Indoor League Ontario Indoor Cup Indoor Tournaments
<b>PRACTICES</b>	Twice a week (mandatory) OYSL may have third optional/mandatory	Twice a week, once a week in a gym (mandatory participation)
<b>GAMES</b>	ERSL Regional: once a week OYSL weekend one/two games (mandatory participation)	Once a week during the weekend (mandatory participation)
<b>SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS</b>	TOP GUN PROGRAM (15 sessions, mandatory participation) GOALKEEPER PROGRAM (15 sessions, mandatory participation) Other as per team specific needs	
<b>AGE GROUPS (MAX # OF PLAYERS PER TEAM)</b>	ERSL Regional U12-U18 11v11 (18) OYSL U14 to U18 11v11 (18)	U12-U18 7v7 (18) Some teams may enter 2 teams in the Coliseum League
<b>COACHING</b>	Certified Club appointed staff coaches with minimum Pre-B for OYSL and Level 3 coaching certificate for ERSL.	
<b>CLUB REGISTRATION FEE COVERS</b>	Fields, referees and assistant referees, league application, insurance, office admin fees, soccer ball and equipment.	Insurance, admin fees, soccer ball and equipment.
<b>ADDITIONAL COSTS</b>	Team budget for specialized programs (Top Gun and GK programs), tournament costs, uniforms, additional player/team equipment, other. Outdoor league supplemental fee for assistant referee assignment. Coaching costs as per Hotspurs Academy Coaching Fee, may apply.	
<b>EQUAL PLAYING TIME</b>	ENCOURAGED in every game. May depend upon player commitment to practice, player effort, attitude shown towards game and practice, player contribution to game, game importance and impact on the players/teams future development. Coaches have authority to impose restricted playing time in games, but must advise CHC beforehand.	
<b>CODE OF CONDUCT</b>	a) Players – YES b) Coaches – YES – Coach may suspend player and report suspension to the Club within 24 hours for final hearing/decision for violation of Code of Conduct for Parents and Code of Conduct for Players c) PARENTS – YES – Parents may report/complain violation of Code of Conduct for Players and Code of Conduct for Coaches to the Coach, Club Head Coach, VP, President and Hotspurs Board of Directors
